

Provost's Global Scholar Program


Academic Year 2024-25

To help achieve UMB's strategic goal of Global Engagement and Education, the Provost's Global Scholar Program was created to help UMB students engage in a critical analysis of, and an engagement with, complex, interdependent global systems and their implications for people's lives and the Earth's sustainability. Through participation in the Provost's Global Scholar Program, in concert with the student's graduate or professional studies, students will conduct research and service projects that address the world's most pressing and enduring challenges.

The Provost's Global Scholar Program provides an opportunity for UMB students to engage in a globally focused experience of their own choosing and design with the support of a \$2,000 stipend. Students from all UMB schools are eligible to apply by proposing a research, service, or learning initiative that must be completed by December 31, 2025. Most students use the stipend for a summer project, but any project timeline between receipt of the award and December 31, 2025, is appropriate.

Appropriate proposals include participation in an international research project; data-gathering; participation in an international conference; participation in an observership or fellowship; a local (US) experience with migrant communities, such as work with refugees; participation in a global service-learning initiative that is part of a long-term sustainable initiative; participation in a clinical program with a global theme (requires approval by student's advisor). Students are also free to propose other globally focused initiatives not included in this list.

All proposed projects must uphold the Guiding Principles of UMB Global Strategic Framework (seen in the purple line below and explained in detail here).



Application Details

Program Details

Eligibility

- Open to all students at all seven UMB schools in any degree program.
- Open to students who are not graduating in Spring 2025 and will be a student in Fall 2025.
- Experience must be completed by December 31, 2025, unless unexpected delays arise that are
- communicated to CGE.
- Students cannot propose participation in a UMB course for credit as their project, except for an
- independent study.

Stipend Details

- Selected students will receive a \$2,000 stipend that can be used to support travel or otherwise support the student's experience.
- The funds are considered an award and therefore are used by the student as financial support, and no accounting is required. However, it is anticipated that most students will use the funds for travel, conference registration, hotel costs, and other expenses for the proposed project.

Application Elements

- Description of proposed project and how it aligns with student's professional interests and
- advances their learning.
- Date of proposed project.
- Explanation of how experience meets the goals of the Provost's Global Scholar Program.
- Explanation of how the experience meets the Guiding Principles.
- Completed Supervisor Approval Form.
- Description of organization or program student will be engaging with during experience.
