Sustainable Lab Purchasing Guidance





Purchasing Tips

Choose reusable options for lab consumables, including:

- Instead of purchasing new pipette tip boxes, reuse boxes and purchase refillable tip racks, saving up to 70%.
- Other reusable wares to consider include media storage bottles, beakers, flasks, and more.

Look for the ACT (accounting, consistency, and transparency) label.







Purchasing Tips

If purchasing large appliances like freezers and refrigeration units, look for the Energy STAR certification.

If purchasing a new fume hood, look for Variable Air Volume (VAV).

Prioritize purchasing items from vendors that utilize more sustainable packaging materials.

 Ex. paper coolers instead of styrofoam, packing paper instead of styrofoam packing peanuts or plastic air pillows

Consolidate orders and buy in bulk to reduce packaging waste and greenhouse gas emissions associated with shipping.
